Collection into our Care

When the time sadly comes that our services are required, we will be here all hours to attend the place you passed away to bring you into our care. We will contact your next-of-kin to express our condolences and to ensure they have our support throughout, answering any questions they may have. When resting in our care, we will provide our care of deceased; we will wash the body and dress in the clothes provided to us, whilst ensuring the Deceased is treated with dignity and the highest level of respect.

All paperwork and legal documentation will be carried out, including any correspondence from the GP surgery, Hospital, the Council, Cemeteries and Crematoriums. If Cremation is the chosen method of committal, the application for Cremation form will be sent to the next-of-kin to complete. We offer 24/7 support if any assistance is required with filling in this form.

If arrangements have not already been conducted through a Pre-Payment Plan, we will carry this out either in our Arranging Room, at a house visit, over the telephone or through email, whichever you prefer. Here, we will arrange the music, the Officiant, the place and method of committal, floral tributes, and more. You will also have the opportunity to choose a coffin from the range supplied by Bradnam's Joinery, as well as alternative urns and keepsake jewellery.

In the days leading to the funeral, we can arrange for a newspaper announcement to be published in your preferred local paper if desired. These can be used to announce a death or the date for the funeral service, allowing for a small tribute from loved ones.

Floral Tributes

There is the opportunity to have floral tributes transported with you to the Crematorium, which will be delivered back to your family afterwards. To view our Florist Daisy's brochure, please visit https://www.daisys-norfolk.co.uk/order_online/Funerals.aspx.

Committal (Cremation)

The committal will take place at your chosen Crematorium for a thirty-minute service. The hearse can go via the family home and close mourners can be transported to the Crematorium, with two limousines provided to follow the hearse. If desired, we are able to take the names of those mourners in attendance before entering the Chapel, which will be returned to the next-of-kin afterwards. Upon arrival at the Crematorium, four bearers will meet the hearse, and when the service is about to begin, the entrance music will be played, and the coffin duly carried to the catafalque.

Once the service ends, the closing music will be played and mourners will exit the Chapel into the Crematorium gardens. As this happens, it is optional for the curtains to close at the catafalque. Donation boxes will be present at the exit, collecting for the charity or organisation of the Deceased's wishes. For those not attending, a donations page in the Deceased's memory will be posted on 'JustGiving' online.

If preferred, a service may take place before the committal at your chosen location before the committal takes place. Memorial services may also be arranged whilst a private committal is held.

Ashes Collection

Three days after the committal, we will collect the ashes from the Crematorium and place them in a Hertford Urn at our Dereham Branch. We will then deliver them to your next-of-kin at their convenience, along with the booklet of remembrance. If you have any specific requests such as scattering or an interment, we can discuss this during the arrangement. When collecting the ashes, we will take the flowers and bring them back to your next-of-kin if they should wish.

Urn

Committal (Burial)

For burials, it is common to hold a service at a place of worship before the committal takes place. Four bearers will be present at the service to carry the coffin to the trestles whilst the opening music plays, which is typically preceded by Hymns, tributes and eulogies, poems, readings and prayers. As the service comes to a close, the coffin will be carried out of the building and taken to the Cemetery for interment. Graveside services may take place for the committal which can be limited to close family if desired.

Memorial

During the arrangements, we will discuss the option of having a memorial service shortly after the committal. We will talk about the music and Hymns you would like played at the service, as well as any prayers or Bible readings, and the Officiant. It is possible to have the ashes present at the service, which may be preceded by an interment if desired.

Cost Breakdown

As a Pre-Payment Plan, the Premium package is available for £5,250 including third-party costs.

Coffin and Urn

As previously mentioned, the Chiltern Oak veneered coffin, with double mouldings and a raised lid will be provided for the Traditional package. For Cremations, a Norfolk Oak urn is also provided for Cremated remains. Both are light oak in colour and have bronze handles attached.
