



## STANDARDISED PRICE LIST – Jordan Young Independent Funeral Home

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

### ATTENDED FUNERAL - Funeral Directors Fees: £2,350

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£900
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (within 30 miles) into the funeral director's care	£230
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be resting in our care at 11 Nelson Place, Dereham.	£195
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be a veneered coffin from a presented selection	£200
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£24
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (within 30 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£350

### UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

<b>Burial (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£1,400</b>
<b>Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)</b>	<b>£1,830</b>

### FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Unattended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b> (Parish Cemetery Fees):	<b>£450</b>
In this local area, the typical cost of the <b>burial fee</b> for local residents in <b>Dereham</b> :	<b>£654</b>
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge for exclusive rights of burial. <b>Grave Digger Fees are not always included in the cemetery fee. Separately this totals:</b>	<b>£320</b>
For an Attended cremation funeral, the <b>cremation fee</b> :	
In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	<b>£980 - £1180</b>

Please discuss any **specific religious, belief-based and/or cultural requirements** that you have with the funeral director.

### ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

Additional mileage (price per mile)	£0.55
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer)	£40
Collection and delivery of ashes	£25
Embalming	£395
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.)	£200 - £230
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	£50

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.
